Equipment

- Glass mortar and pestle
- 50mL graduated measure
- Stirring rod
- Gloves x1 pair
- Mask x1
- Chemo gown & mat
- 50mL clean amber glass bottle x1
- Shrink seal

NOTE: GLOVES, CHEMO GOWN AND MASK MUST BE WORN WHEN MAKING THIS SUSPENSION AND MAKE IN SAFETY HOOD.



Procedure

1. Lay down a surgical chemo mat then place all the equipment and ingredients inside the biohazard box.
2. Put on chemo gown, gloves and mask
3. Wet the Azathioprine tablets in the mortar with a small amount of Vehicle before crushing them.
4. Levigate with small amounts of Vehicle until a smooth paste is formed. Add more Vehicle to the paste until a liquid is formed. Transfer to the graduated measure. Use additional Vehicle to rinse the remaining drug from the mortar.
5. Make up to final volume in the graduated measure with vehicle. Stir well.
6. Transfer the suspension to the amber bottle.
7. Label and affix shrink seal.
8. Collect all the waste and put it in a biohazard container.
9. Wash the safety hood with just water and soap, then wipe stainless steel surfaces with 70% alcohol.
