Equipment

- 30mL graduated measure
- 250mL graduated measure
- mortar and pestle
- glass stirring rod
- 250mL clean amber bottle
- shrink seal


✓ Procedure

1. Place Nitrazepam tablets and Sterile Water in the mortar. Let sit for a few minutes to soften the tablets.
2. Levigate the tablets and water to a smooth paste. Add small quantities of vehicle until a liquid is formed. Transfer the contents of the mortar to the graduated measure. Use additional vehicle to rinse remaining drug from the mortar.
3. Make up to final volume using SickKids Suspending Vehicle. Stir well.
4. Transfer the suspension to an amber bottle.
5. Label and apply shrink seal.
