The patient	is attending the Endocrinology
Department at The Hospital for Sick Children and has been prescribed specific Adrenal	
insufficiency treatment (Solucortef vials and/or Hydrocortisone/Prednisolone liquid	
and/or Florinef tablets). The Florin	ef must be kept in a cooler bag with ice packs. The
Solucortef is given by injection and requires needles and syringes. Due to the nature of	

the medication it must remain with the patient at all times (ie: carry on baggage only). Feel free to search this product by hand and contact the clinic for any further information.
