> The Hospital for Sick Children Electronic Formulary > Drugs > Enter drug name into the search engine

Monographs include (but are not limited to) the following fields:

- Supplied at SickKids*
- Therapeutic class/category
- Dose in newborn infants*
- Dose in infants and older children*
- Restrictions
- Additional comments*
- Links to SickKids guideline documents*
- Contraindications/warnings
- Adverse reactions, drug interactions
- Monitoring parameters

Charts/Special Topics > Enter *keyword* into search engine. These include (but not limited to):

- IV administration guidelines*
- Therapeutic drug monitoring*
- Other clinical documents* e.g. Antimicrobial, pain service, stroke, status epilepticus, sickle cell, hematology/oncology, vaccines

*These fields are specific to SickKids.

* Update at least monthly to stay current with changes made by the Drug Information Service.

Application Info > Preferences >

- Font Size: Adjust using the slider
- Theme: Change how the drug monograph is displayed

Interact

Tap + to add a new drug > Enter *drug name* into the search engine > **Done** > Repeat to add subsequent drugs. To analyze drug interactions, return to **Interact** menu > **Analyze**. Tap **Clear** to start over.

3 Drug ID

Identify drugs by description or identifiers.

- Enter description based on *imprint*, *dosage form*, *shape*, and *color* > **Search**.
- Enter identifier using free-form text.

If Database primarily uses American drug products and may not include Canadian equivalents.

4 Lexi-Calc

Find built-in calculators. Organize by **Category** and/or search by *keyword*. Useful calculators include:

- Body surface area (Mosteller Method)
- Ideal body weight: Pediatric
- Glomerular filtration rate by Bedside Schwartz
- CDC height, weight, BMI for age
- WHO length, weight for age

I Other calculations may not be endorsed or used as standard SickKids practice. Consult when necessary.

5 IV Compatibility (Trissel's™)

Tap + to add a new drug or solution > Enter *drug or solution name* into the search engine > Repeat to add subsequent drugs or solutions. To analyze compatibility > **Analyze**. Tap **Clear** to start over.
