Welcome to the SickKids ABILITY Clinic!

These resources were created to give you some information about Down Syndrome. It is meant to be a concise and helpful guide. Many caregivers feel overwhelmed when they find out that their child will develop in a different way from other children. Like other parents who are told their child has Down Syndrome, you may find that you do not know where to start, what to read, or where to go first. We also hope that this information will provide you with direction, information, and comfort as you begin to understand what lies ahead for your child and family.

The mandate of our program is to provide consultative medical and developmental care to children with Down Syndrome and to support their families. We work in collaboration with Surrey Place Centre and Centennial Infant and Child Centre to provide developmental support and guidance, and to coordinate community services. We work alongside your primary care provider to ensure that the necessary health supervision guidelines as outlined by the American Academy of Paediatrics are being followed and to help coordinate medical teams in your child's circle of care.
