

SickKids Summer Research (SSuRe) Program

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| Student Eligibility | Research Summer Students are selected for research training (basic science or clinical) under the supervision of a scientist at SickKids. All students in an undergraduate or medical degree program are eligible to apply, with the exception of graduate students (Master's and/or PhD). |
| Program Start Date | The SSuRe Program curriculum officially starts on May 2, 2022 and ends after Symposium Day on August 8, 2022. |
| Stipend Amount | \$14.35/hour + 6% vacation pay for the duration of the research training period. Research Summer Students will be paid biweekly through payroll. |
| Program Requirements | <p>Research Summer Students are encouraged to participate in the SSuRe Program curriculum, which includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research Summer Student Meet & Greet • Weekly Seminar Series • Career Night • Symposium Day |
| How to Apply | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A list of scientists who are actively recruiting positions is available online at the SSuRe Program Job Postings page. If you are interested in working with a scientist that is not actively recruiting, you are welcome to contact those scientists directly about the possibility of working with them on. 2. <u>To apply to posted positions, you must apply to the posting directly.</u> Human Resource Services or the SSuRe Program will not or forward applications. 3. <u>Application documents:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This Student Application form • Your CV/resume and cover letter • A copy of your University transcripts • One reference letter (e.g. from a professor or previous employer) |
| Deadline to Apply | <p>The deadline for students to submit their applications to posted Research Summer Student positions is posted on our website.</p> <p>Students are encouraged to apply as early as possible as scientists are free to select their students for the program at any time. Most selections will be made many weeks before this final deadline.</p> <p>Due to the high volume of applications received, only those students selected for an interview will be contacted. Please follow up with the scientist as the SSuRe Program does not manage the hiring process.</p> |
